ON CAMPUS PARKING OPTIONS

GW's Foggy Bottom Campus offers a number of campus parking lots to accommodate faculty, staff, students, and visitors to the campus. Visitors may park at the Marvin Center (7am-midnight), 1957 E Street (7am-10pm), and Ambulatory Care Center (7am-8pm). The G Street Garage and the University Parking Garage (located under Science and Engineering Hall) are 24 hour self service garages.

Monthly contract parking is available to students, faculty, and staff at a variety of locations throughout the campus.
